



ROUTINE EXAMINATIONS AND IMMUNIZATIONS

Birth (Hospital)	Newborn Screen and <u>HepB</u>
1-3 Days	Newborn Exam and <u>HepB</u> (if not given in the hospital)
2 Weeks	Second Newborn Screen
1 Month	Exam
2 Months	Exam and <u>DTaP, Hib, PCV, IPV, HepB, RV</u>
4 Months	Exam and <u>DTaP, Hib, PCV, IPV, RV</u>
6 Months	Exam and <u>DTaP, Hib, PCV, RV, Flu (if needed)</u>
9 Months	Exam and <u>IPV, Flu (if needed)</u> , Hemoglobin
12 Months	Exam and <u>MMR, Varicella, HepA, Flu (if needed)</u> , Hemoglobin, Lead Level
15 Months	Exam and <u>DTaP, Hib, PCV, Flu (if needed)</u> , Hemoglobin
18 Months	Exam and <u>HepB, Flu (if needed), PCV (if needed)</u>
2 Years	Exam and <u>HepA, Flu (if needed), PCV (if needed)</u> , Lead Level
2 1/2 Years	Developmental Exam, <u>Flu (if needed)</u> , Hemoglobin
3 Years	Developmental Exam, Vision Screen, <u>Flu (if needed), PCV (if needed)</u>
4 Years	Developmental Exam, Vision/Hearing Screens, <u>DTaP, MMR, Varicella, IPV, Flu (if needed), PCV (if needed)</u>
5 Years	Developmental Exam, Urine Analysis, Vision/Hearing Screens, <u>Flu (if needed)</u>
6-10 Years	Exam, <u>Flu (if needed)</u> , Cholesterol Screening/Vision/Hearing/Urine Analysis (9yr only)
11 Years	Exam, <u>Tdap, MCV, HPV, Flu (if needed), Varicella (if needed)</u> , Cholesterol Screening
12-13 Years	Exam, <u>Flu (if needed)</u>
14 Years	Exam, <u>Flu (if needed)</u> , Hemoglobin, Urine Analysis and Cholesterol Screening
15-18 Years	Exam, <u>Flu (if needed), MCV (16 yr only)</u> , Cholesterol Screening (17yr only), Cholesterol Screening/Hemoglobin/Urine Analysis (18yr only)

Ages 3-18 Years – Well check exams are recommended every year. Sports physicals must be obtained on a yearly basis.
